# \* 2019-2020 \*

This is the 44th annual report of the Wichita Audubon Society and Chaplin

Nature Center. This report highlights the activities for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020. Chaplin Nature Center is owned and operated by the Wichita Audubon Society, with operations directed by the CNC committee of the board of directors.



#### **MEETINGS**

Thanks to Covid, we only had five meetings instead of our usual eight.

September started us off with our own vice-president Rachel Roth telling us about the latest fossil discoveries that show how modern birds are the descendants of the dinosaurs.

## Citizen Science & Service Projects

We began with the annual butterfly count at Chaplin Nature Center. An official project of the North American Butterfly Association, we locate and count butterflies in a 15-mile diameter circle.

Despite the heat, we found 354 individuals of 36 species. In September we tagged Monarch butterflies as part of Monarch-Watch. It was a rainy day, but seventy



people managed to tag 25 monarchs on their way to Mexico. In October we held a trash pickup in Chisholm Creek Park.

# Citizen Science,

Lots of people gathered lots of trash, including 28 from the Boy Scouts Order of the Arrow and 15 - 20 others.

In the winter we contributed to Christmas bird counts. Wichita Audubon supports and promotes numerous counts in Wichita, Winfield-Udall, El Dorado, Slate Creek, Sedan, Arkansas City, Marion, and the Red Hills. Plus out members

participate in several other counts throughout Kansas. All the data is reported to the National Audubon Society, and is part of a database more than 100 years

old documenting bird locations and abundance.

We are also participating in Cast-It-In-Kansas, a project to collect used fishing line and prevent it from entangling wildlife. Rex Herndon has installed and is monitoring 6 bins for us at Veteran's Lake, Arkansas City, Cowley County State Fishing Lake, Sedan Old City Lake and Sedan New City Lake. This year he collected 1.62 lbs of line, which were sent to be recycled.



### MEETINGS, CONTINUED

In October Dr. Ryan Klataske shared his

experiences with wildlife management and conservation in Namibia. November was a look at road kill. Dr. Bill Langley shared his two-year study of road mortality on K254 and his conclusions from his gruesome work. In January we watched a delightful film, "Wetlands

Food Chain," filmed in Cheyenne Bottoms by Mike Blair. Our last program, in February, was a trip to Australia with Jim and Patty Marlett.

After the stay at home order and the risk of infection further meetings were cancelled. But we have been able to reschedule all our missed programs for the coming year.



We began our fall trips with an old favorite: Quivira and Cheyenne Bottoms. Led by Tom Ewert, we saw both Wilson's and Red-necked



Phalarope, a Buff-breasted Sandpiper, and a half-dozen Western Grebes. In October we were treated to a ramble through the Cross Timbers region with Pete Janzen. It was a lovely fall day with many thousands of Franklin's Gulls on the lakes. November was our annual trip to Quivira to see cranes. We missed the

Whooping Crane by one day, but did get good looks at four Tundra Swans.
We had several beginner bird watchers

along, so everything was new. In

January we had our extended field trip to the Rio Grande Valley. Twenty - two people were along for visits to places such as Laguna Atacosa NWR, South Padre Island, Santa Ana NWR, Fontera Audubon Sanctuary, Estero Llano Grande State Park, and many more. Our rental vans made it all go

ended with a total of 167 species

In February we did some local tropical birding at the Tropics building at the Sedgwick County Zoo. About 25 people came






to find all

# 6,234 visitors for 2019-20

Shawn Silliman, our naturalist, presented programs for 63 groups, reaching 1,485 people. This number is down somewhat do to the early closing of schools. We were

extra busy all spring with families seeking outdoor adventures. There were eight public programs, beginning with the Butterfly Count in July, and the Friday the 13th Full Moon Walk/

Run. There was Fall Nature Day in September, star gazing in October, Bald Eagle hikes in January and February, viewing a Bald Eagle nest in March and kayaking on the Arkansas river in June. Volunteers donated 394 hours of their time. Seven groups totaling 327 people used the nature center for weddings, business meetings and reunions.
